To ensure the efficient use of court resources and to ensure that defendants' requests for enrollment and, or extension for completion of Defensive Driving School are accomplished in a timely and efficient manner

IT IS ORDERED that any Defensive Driving School certified by the Arizona Supreme Court and meeting the reporting requirements of the Maricopa County Justice Courts shall grant a defendant's request for an extension of sixty (60) calendar days to complete Defensive Driving School Diversion.

An extension may only be granted once and for the first set court arraignment date on the citation. If an extension is granted, the student shall complete the defensive driving school course at least seven days prior to the new court arraignment date.

Arizona Supreme Court certified schools may not grant a continuance if the request for extension is less than 7 days prior to the arraignment date, and shall instead, direct the student to the appropriate court.

This administrative order is effective October 1, 2022.

In addition

IT IS ORDERED that any additional requests for extensions must be made by request to the Justice of the Peace in the precinct wherein the violation occurred.

In addition

IT IS ORDERED that Court Managers shall develop internal court procedures necessary to ensure compliance with this administrative order.

In addition

IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Maricopa County Justice Court Policy 1.1.3, this Administrative Directive shall expire on 9/30/2023 unless rescinded earlier or replaced with another policy or directive pursuant to Maricopa County Justice Court policy.
