How to...

REPORT AN UNPAID (tort motor vehicle) JUDGMENT TO MVD



MARICOPA COUNTY JUSTICE COURTS

If your judgment is the result of damages from a motor vehicle accident and your judgment remains unpaid for more than **SIXTY calendar DAYS** after the judgment was rendered, you or your attorney may request a suspension of the judgment debtors driver license and vehicle registration.

Please **STOP:**

- If there is no judgment rendered in your favor.
- If there is a satisfaction of judgment filed.
- If the claim did not involve a vehicular accident.
- 60 days have not elapsed since judgment was rendered.

Please **PROCEED:**

If you have not received payment from the judgment debtor and at least 60 days have elapsed since judgment.

FORMS Needed:

Certificate of Judgment Status

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Request a certified copy of the underlying judgment (from the court clerk). You will not be charged a fee for this certification.
2. Complete and sign the form included in this packet, CERTIFICATE OF JUDGMENT STATUS. File the form with the court.
3. The court clerk will complete the certification and mail it with the accident report and the certified copy of the underlying judgment to the Motor Vehicle Department.
