Obtaining Your 39-Month MVR

If you need to prove to the court that your driver license is/was valid at the time of your citation, you will need to provide a specific type of motor vehicle record. This comes from the Arizona Motor Vehicle Division and may be retrieved online.

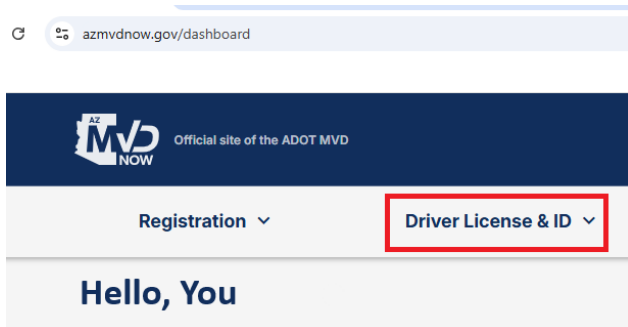
1. LOG IN (CREATE ACCOUNT IF NECESSARY)

Go to <https://azmvdnow.gov> and sign in or create an account if you do not have one.

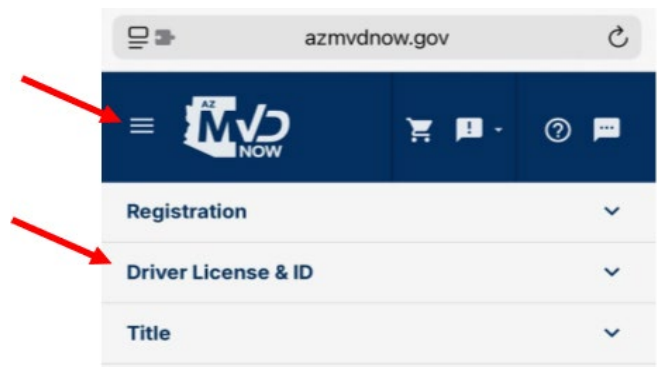
2. PLACE THE ORDER

Once you are signed in, find and click or tap **DRIVER LICENSE & ID**

On a computer it will be near the top:

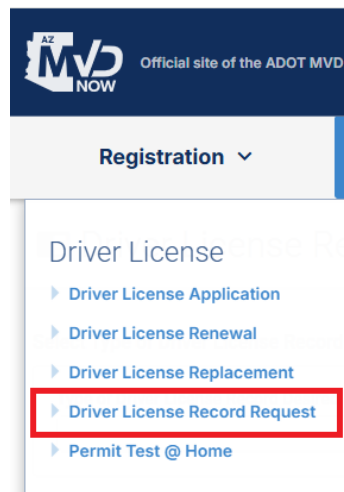


On a mobile phone tap the 3 bars to reveal it:
